The Angelina County Historic Sites Survey Collection consists of three volumes and a photograph album produced during the 1986 Historic Site Survey and National Register Multiple Resource Nomination project. The collection is a record of historically significant structures such as houses, churches, schools, and commercial buildings throughout the county.

Biographical/Historical Note:

In 1986 Victor and Victor Consultants, in cooperation with the Texas Historical Commission and the Angelina County Historical Commission, completed a Historic Site Survey and National Register Multiple Resource Nomination. According to the survey, a prominent reason for initiating the project was because there were no National Register of Historic Places site designations in Angelina County. The project team surveyed 1,050 sites that were approximately 50 years old or older.

Collection Scope and Content:

The Angelina County Historic Sites Survey Collection consists of three volumes and a photograph album from the 1986 Historic Site Survey and National Register Multiple Resource Nomination. The collection

is a record of historically significant structures such as houses, churches, schools, and commercial buildings throughout the county.

The three volumes comprise the site survey itself. The volumes contain information on all of the project participants, survey purpose and methodology, a roster of sites recommended for the National Register, and Angelina County history and historic resources. They also contain the survey forms, listing the site name, location, description, significance, architecture, and other information typical of a site survey. The photograph album contains approximately 104 8x10 copy prints from the Texas Historical Commission showing houses and commercial buildings in Diboll. Between 10 and 15 photos are missing. The photographs are numbered and coincide with the site numbers in the survey volumes.
