Collection Abstract:

This collection consists of aerial surveys and a flight line map of East Texas and western Louisiana dating from 1993-1994 and created for Temple-Inland. Although the surveys do not label city and place names, bodies of water, railroads, oil and gas wells, pipelines, and county lines like the 1930s Edgar Tobin surveys, they provide a record of East Texas and Louisiana geography in the mid 1990s.

Collection Scope and Content:

This collection consists of approximately 1,211 black and white aerial photographic surveys depicting East Texas and western Louisiana, as well as a flight line map for reference and survey location identification. The flight line map states that the surveys were created between June and October of 1993, but some surveys are dated March 1994. The flight line map also states the approximate scale of photography as being 1"=3,333', but several surveys give the scale 1"=40,000'. The surveys measure 23 ¾ x 23 ¾ inches. The company who created the surveys is unknown, but they were created for Temple-Inland. Unlike the Edgar Tobin aerial surveys of the 1930s, the 1993-1994 surveys are not labeled with city and place names, bodies of water, railroads, oil and gas wells, pipelines, and county lines.

The flight line map marks the following Texas cities falling within the survey region, but it is not an exhaustive list: Orange, Beaumont, Cleveland, Kountze, Buna, Livingston, Woodville, Kirbyville, Groveton, Corrigan, Jasper, northern Crockett, Lufkin, San Augustine, eastern Palestine, Rusk, Alto, Nacogdoches, and Carthage. Other towns are depicted but are not labeled on the flight line map. Cities in Louisiana include Merryville, DeQuincy, Lake Charles, DeRidder, Leesville, Oakdale, and Jennings. Please see the shaded map at the end of this finding guide for a visualization of the survey region.
