Collection Abstract: The Bill Goodrum Forestry Collection was created by Bill Goodrum during his tenure managing Temple-Inland's forests, first as a wildlife biologist and then Manager of Forest Environmental Issues. The collection contains subject files, correspondence, administrative files, publications, and audiovisual media and includes documents pertaining to forest management, wildlife management, environmental concerns, and compliance with industry initiatives in regards to environmental controls and protection.

Initial processing of the collection was completed in April 2008. The finding guide was further revised in June 2012.

Biographical/Historical Note:

The documents in the Bill Goodrum Collection reflect Bill Goodrum's long tenure managing Temple-Inland's forests. Goodrum received his Bachelor of Science degree from Texas A&M University in Range

Science and Wildlife Science in 1979 and his Master of Science in Forestry in 1990. He worked for two years with the Natural Resource Conservation Service and then moved to Temple-Inland as a regional wildlife biologist, a position he held until 1992. From 1992-1999, Goodrum was Manager of Forest Environmental Issues in the Environmental Affairs Department and in 1999 he became Manager of Forest Practices and Principles. The bulk of this collection dates from this period, as Goodrum was tasked with ensuring that Temple-Inland's forest operations and forestry practices were in line with new industry standards for sustainable forestry.

Collection Scope and Content:

Though it covers the years 1971-2003, the bulk of this collection concerns Temple-Inland's forestry practices from 1998-2002. In this time period, the company implemented a large-scale effort to standardize their forestry practices, bringing their operations into compliance with accepted industry Best Practice Management Standards to earn the ISO14001 Certification and recognition under the Sustainable Forestry Initiative.
