Collection Abstract: This collection contains records related to the administrative aspect of the Diboll Historical Society from 1984 to 2021. Donated in two accessions, one by Becky Donahoe and one by Linda Maxey, the collection chronicles the financial and administrative history of the organization through financial and bank statements, meeting minutes and agendas, correspondence, grant applications, oral history procedures, and the charter and incorporation of the organization.

Author/Processing Information: This collection was processed by Allison Grimes in 2020.

Biographical/Historical Note: The Diboll Historical Society was chartered in 1985. It was formed initially to undertake completing oral history interviews about life in Diboll. These oral history interviews were later published together to form a history of Diboll in *The Cornbread Whistle*. The Society continued its mission in preserving the history of Diboll for many years. In 2003, they were pleased with the opening of The History Center in Diboll, a partner in preservation. The society conducted meetings at The History Center for several years, including the staff of the facility in their membership numbers. At the end of 2021, the Diboll Historical Society made the final decision to end its tenure, officially disbanding the organization.

Collection Scope and Content: This collection contains financial information, including bank statements and financial statements of the Diboll Historical Society. There are also meeting agendas and minutes, tax information, charter information, correspondence, and other documents related to the

administrative running of the Diboll Historical Society as an organization. Additionally, there are newspaper articles, event programs, and artifacts commemorating Diboll historical events.
