Collection Abstract:

St. Cyprian's Episcopal School began as a concept for a "day school" serving kindergarten, nursery, and private first grade classes under the direct supervision of St. Cyprian's Episcopal Church in Lufkin, Texas. In 1955, under Rector John Francis Caskey, this concept moved away from direct church supervision. A private non-denominational school was established, supervised by a school board in association with the church. The year 1969 saw a period of transition as fire damaged the original church and school campus at Paul Avenue and Second Street. A site was selected at the corner of Pershing and John Redditt Drive, where construction for the new church and school was completed on July 30, 1972. This collection contains albums, CDs, clippings, newspapers, photographs, publications, records, scrapbooks, slides, plaques, and oversized photographs showing the various students who attended the school and events which impacted its development from 1955-2022.

Biographical/Historical Note:

St. Cyprian's Episcopal School began as a concept in early 1955, when St. Cyprian's Episcopal Church planned the creation of a "day school" with kindergarten, nursery, and private first grade classes under church supervision. Minimum enrollment was to be sixty students. Upon becoming Rector in June 1955, John Francis Caskey pushed to make the idea a reality, the main change being that it would operate in

association with, instead of directly under the church. This structure operated along similar lines to a school he established in Galveston, Texas. Under the title St. Cyprian's Day School, pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, primary, and secondary school students in Lufkin, Texas, received a private non-denominational education under the direction of a school board. By February 1965, more than one hundred kindergarten and elementary students were in attendance, increasing the number of classes for each grade from one to two.

On October 13, 1969, a fire destroyed or damaged all church facilities on Paul Avenue and Second Street, including the school. The Vestry, after careful deliberation, came to a resolution on January 26, 1970, that a new church and school be constructed away from the old site. A new property, previously owned by Mrs. Odom, was selected at the corner of Pershing and John Redditt Drive. The firm Greasen, Evans, and Rogers was selected to provide architectural plans. To raise funds for construction, several fund-raising campaigns were initiated with the help of Ward, Hannum, and Reinhardt, Inc. and Ross Ossman. Over a six-year period, the church received pledges of \$526,000. This, in combination with funds generated from the sale of the old site, provided the necessary funds to begin construction and reduced the church's debts in the long term. On June 29, 1971, a ground breaking ceremony was conducted on the new site, kicking off construction of four new facilities by the firm L. Richardson & Sons, which were completed on July 30, 1972.

Collection Scope and Content:

The St. Cyprian's Episcopal Church collection is arranged in eleven series. The first series contains rehoused photo albums from 1978-1997, showing different class trips and students.

The second series contains CDs with class pictures and events from 2004-2007.

The third series contains clippings, primarily from Diboll Free Press and Lufkin Daily News, from 1956-2019.

The fourth series contains newspapers, primarily Lufkin Daily News, from 1996-2018.

The fifth series contains photographs, with associated negatives and slides, from 1957-2022, undated.

The sixth series contains publications, primarily The Clarion, TJ Mag & Co., and Charm East Texas, from 1971-2016, undated.

The seventh series contains records, including Board of Directors meeting minutes and marketing materials, from 1955-2020, undated.

The eighth series contains scrapbooks from 1955-1995, undated.

The ninth series contains slides from 1984-1989.

The tenth series contains plaques from Christmas Parade and Angelina Chamber of Commerce, from 2016, undated.

The eleventh series contains fifty-nine oversized color photographs on canvas and foam board in various dimensions, undated.

Arrangement: The collection is arranged in series by content types, then by date within those series. The collection contains albums, CDs, clippings, newspapers, photographs, publications, records, scrapbooks, slides, and oversized photographs.
