You know it was four (4) weeks ago to day when we were up there, and it was a month ago the (26)th of Jan since Lettie has saw her mother, but I guess we will have to content ourselves the best we can. maybe we can come sometime in the near future. I hope Darnard and Emma are O.K. by now.

Lettie talked to Dorothy

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yesterday eve, she wanted us to come by her house if we got to come up there. I am sure that she wants to come home as bad as I do. we thought Dorthy and Toby might eat dinner with us today but they havent come yet, and it is ~~Almont~~ (11) eleven o'clock now.

I ~~never~~ have got as tired in my life as I have the past few weeks trying to work in the mud. we had to ware rubber boots over our shoes and you see that mad them so heavy on our feet. I havent got my feet

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wet so far while out trying to work. we make it pretty easy while the weather is bad but when it does dry up so we can ~~work~~, then we will have to hit it pretty hard, but I won't mind it if the weather will just stay pretty.

Oh yes I have the Car in a Car-house now; believe me it is a good house with a floor. I ~~get~~ it free of rent for two (2) weeks, and if I let it stay longer it will cost me fifty cents a month, but I want to get it home by then.
