I did not learn of your misfortune untill on Wednesday last week, I was by Lillies and Everetts, at that time, and Everett, told me then. that week end Billy Maud, Tressie and I went to Hill county, Tressie stoped at ther mothers and Billy Maud babay and my self went down to Uncle Westons, near Waco, Billy had not been down there sance we put mother away July 21st. 1935 we went out to mothers grave, ~~at~~ you know she is place on my lot in Hubbard, the lot is well taken care of my father in law has her grave cover with her favorite flower verbena, then we have lots of other flowers also.

I have been just about down for five or six weeks am loosing all my teeth, and then I will have to go back to Chicago, next month for more ~~at~~ radium, I went to the doctor today, Tressie is not to well but still going, I Had a letter from Aunt Dellars girl monday, Aunt Dellard like to have died in January she tells me but able to be up now, I also Had a letter from ~~at~~ our lawyer, the property will be devided in June or July, as soon as we get posision of our part I will try to get a buyer, we will have to make a price amoung our selves to give or take so much for our interest, which is $1/6$ of $1/5$ of the whole the lawyer told me that he would set a price that he would give so much for all our part or he would take the same price for his part which is $1/3$ of our 106 acares, something beats nothing, Preston has the place rented for this year that is all of it, I will keep you advised what happens, must now be going let me hear from all of you, love and best wishes to all I am
