Dear Sister & Family:-

Will try to answer your letter which I received several days back, indeed glad to hear from all of you, I am feeling some better but not at all well, and don't think I will ever be well again as I should be, I have been home something over a week as they did all they could for me in the hospital in Muskogee, Okla. My heart is still giving me lots of trouble and always will so the Doctors tell me I could have stayed at the hospital as long as I cared too, but the Doctors told me that I could do as I liked stay there or come home as they the Drs. had done all they could and that I would do as well one place as the other.

I have been placed to total disability for life and a pension of \$30.00 monthly for life, if I can not work I surely will need the \$30.00 each month and then some, but the \$30.00 will help a great deal, it would be much worse without the pension you see I have lost all my teeth and won't get new ones before November this year, I also have to use the bifocal glasses also, now only weigh 156 pounds and three months ago I weighed 174.

Saw Curtis yesterday all was well so he said, saw Billy and folks a couple of days back all well but the baby she had the measles, just had a letter from Erin, he said all was as well as common I believe I told you about Erin's oldest boy has T.B. also lost his mind and is in the hospital at Wichita Falls, Texas. no chance of being any better, he is 23 year of age now weighs less than 100 pounds.

I am told that Erins girl will finish high school this week, I got her card, also three or four other cards from youngsters whom I know here in ths city.

I have not heard from my lawyer in Caldwell lately, but if the case should come up he will advise me as to the date, it should come up in this spring term of Cival Courts of Appeals, guess we will get it all wound up this year, I had a letter from Chane Cummings, while I was in the Hospital, he toldme that Preston was in bad health and that Mable his wife was in bad shape with her legs, think he has what is called the milk leg, anyway her legs has been sore for four or five years I know, Chance also said Preston's children all was down with the measeels, he has nine living, one dead one married eight at home all sick at one time encluding Mable, that sounds tough, Preston is now living in Clay, however he is working the farm, has it rented from the Courts, we should get a little rent this year after the taxes are paid Ect.

It has been raining here all day today and most of last night, also rained Sunday night most of sunday and monday we need about two weeks of good hot sunshine here at present.

I have orders to do nothing but fish and camp out when the weather is good, the night are a little too cool as yet, if I am able I aim to come down for a couple of days next month and go fishing at Hill lake would you like to go? I want to go to Galveston, for a couple of weeks in August at which time I will see your attorney and go by the farm and see how things looks. I think I told you about Tressies baby sister loosin her husband he died ll of Feb. 1940 left a wife to little girls 3 & 5 years old, no insurance or money a bunch of debts was all it is awful on the wife and babies, he was 40 years
