Guess you all are worried about the war almost as bad as I am, but we cant help it we will have to do the best we can. Well I am sure if I had waited untill now, they would have drafted me in the army anyway. I would feel a little better if I could come home Xmas, but I dont know for sure yet if I will get off, but I am hopeing I do.

Believe me we are having some bad weather up here now, guess we will have plenty of rain now as it has been dry a good while, but we havent had much real cold weather yet. Say, have you heard wheather Aaron has been called yet or not? I guess they will get all the men now that they can get. I dont need my suit up here now as they wont let us ware any cloths except uniform.

You never did say wheather you had got your cotton stamps yet or not, I hope you have. I think you are supose to get a pariety check pretty soon. Oh yes, I got a letter from Edna and Marie yesterday, they were OK. Marie said she might get married Xmas, I bet she does, she said she was making 54 ¢ an hour working at the Continial can company. Mama I have not forgot that you have a birthday coming, I will send you something if I dont get to come home. You all take care of yourselves and write me often.
