Jan 9, 1942

Dear Home folks:

I was very glad to get your letter today, but was sorry to learn that Emma Dean was having a thasma again. I don't see why it has been so much worse on her this winter than usual, may-be she don't take care of herself as she should and take medicine when she needs it. I hope this will find you all well, I am about the same as usual.

I don't see why you had not got my letter and the money I sent it Jan 2nd, by Registered mail and if you have not got it by the time you get this, you write me right back as soon as you get this and let me know if you got it or not. Oh yes, I told you

that I had got the shirt and
peanuts, of which I thank you
all so much for sending
them, the peanuts sure were good,
but I guess I will send the white
shirts back to you as we can
not wear them up here. I sure hope
you have got that letter by now.
You said Dennerd was writing
me a letter, but I guess you for-
got to put it in with your letter.

mama, please don't worry so
much about things we can not
help, I have not been sick, you
know I always write you all pretty
often, you know the mail gets delayed
sometimes.

I sure dread to see this kind
of weather, we still have plenty of
snow and ice on the ground, we
have had a little sunshine to-day
but it hasn't shine much the

past week. Mama you all don't
expose yourselves out in the bad
weather, don't let Dennerd get out
to go to school when it is so bad.
maybe you all won't get the "flu" if
you will be careful and take
care of yourselves.

I got a letter from Gillie the
other day, she said her nerves were
in bad shape, and that she would
have to take shots for a while. I am
afraid she has a bad heart, she
did not say whether she would
have to quite work for a few days
or not.

I registered this letter so I thought
you might get it sooner. I sure thank
you for sending me those papers
too as I enjoy reading the Times so
much. I was expecting a letter but
I failed to get it with the papers.
I guess you will be hearing from that
insurance at Center in a few days as
it is due in this month. I ~~want~~ ^{want} you

too pay it for me and I will pay
 you back the money as soon as I get
 another payday. I owe Mr Prince
 \$1.60 on my insurance. I havent paid
 any on it in a year.

well Dennerd, how are you getting
 along in school, and what kind of
 games do you all play, do you ever
 play baseball? Guess you all have
 made some ice Cream as you have plenty
 of ice. Those peanuts sure were good,
 when are you going to send me some
 more? I will send you some stamps
 as I would like for you to send me
 the "Times" about ever two weeks. How
 is Dorthy and family? I havent heard
 from them but one time sence I was
 down there. Oh yes, you know Dr. Copland
 has a grandson up here he is Charles
 witcher. I havent got to see him yet. I met
 a Rhodes boy up here from down there.
 mama, you know his mother is a sister to
 Mrs Lottie Hughes, he is kin to the Princes.
 you all write me ~~the~~ the day you get
 this letter. Trusting I will hear from you
 soon.
