Dear Home folks:

I know you all will think I got in a hurry to ans your letter, but I wanted to write anyway as I didnt write anything but a Card yesterday when I mailed the packages.

I was glad to get your letters today and to learn that you were O.K, hope this will find you all well, I am about the same as usual, but you can guess about how I feel as I have to get most of my sleep in the daytime and that is poor sleep.

yes; I had already heard about the big rain's you all had as I had got a letter from Dorothy and a Card from Alford this week, I sure hate to hear about it, sure is bad but I am sure it could be worse, I think we all should be so thankful that things are as well ^{with} us as it is. we don't see why such rains has to come, but there are lots of things

happen that we don't understand. I know you all have worked hard and have tried to make something, but just think what I have spent on trying to help you make a crop last year and this year too; however I was glad that I had that much to help you as I could not be there my-self, but we will just have to do the best we can. Hope the rain doesn't cause the tomatoes to rot. Do you have very many more to sell yet? And how much are they paying per lb for tomatoes now? Glad you had got the potatoes dug, did you sell any of them? Say; why didn't you get a roll of that paper and have Ellis to cover your chick house? it would not have cost much.

well; I went to Dallas Sunday morning, got to Lillie's about eleven o'clock, the trip didn't cost me any-thing as I had good luck catching rides, I rode almost to Dallas in the same car going down there. I left there Monday eve about five (5) o'clock and got to Wichita at about nine (9) o'clock. They were all OK & kept Lillie was puny again. I think Emma Dean is coming home in a few days.
