June 24, 1942

Dear Home folks:

Just received your letter today, of which I was glad to get and to learn that you all were O.K., hope this will find you all well, I am about the same as usual. I was disappointed yesterday as I did not hear from you all as I was expecting, I think sometimes you all don't ans my letter's soon enough, but I know you all have lots of work to do anyway.

Mama, you know you put Lillie's letter in with mine, so I am sending it right on to her, but I guess you have written her another one

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by now any-way. Guess you have heard from them sence Lillie had another spell and they took her to the Hospital, Emma Dean wrote me they were going to remove Lillies "Tonsils". I ~~have~~ haven't heard from them but one time sence I was down there.

Yes; I sure would have like to been down there last Sunday, I know you all were glad to see Aunt Orange & the Children. I would like to see them. If you will send me Aunt Orange's and Lottie's Address I will write to them. How is Dorthey & family? wish she would ans my letter.

Mama; you didnt say a word about Ellis, and not much

about Dennerd. Have you had any ripe tomatoes yet? hope they don't rot much. Are the people about there selling tomatoes now? I saw in the paper where Timpson sure was on a "boom" for a few days. Say, Ellis why didn't you and Dennerd write me a few lines too? I know you all are blue and discouraged but, it doesn't do any good to worry if it had, I would have been out of the Army now. we all just have to do the best we can. You know I will help you all as long as I have anything to help with. Well; Dennerd I was disappointed in you not writing me. Did you get the stamp book? mama didn't say anything about it in her letter, do you have

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Air mail stamps? I Can get you some if you want some.

Have they worked the Cemetery yet? hope they have. I went to the baptist Church Sunday morning, heard a good father's day sermon.

Ellis, have you tryed to work or "Brake" tillie any yet? Are you all going to have any ripe watermelons about the 4th of july? hope you do. Dont guess you will try to fertilizie your Cotton if it keeps raining. How is the tomato price holding up? It dont look like it would rain up here now in six months, hope you all have a dry spell now. I dont have any news. Take Care of yourselves and Ans soon,
