

Friday Night:

March 3, 1944

Dear mama:

I was very glad to get your letter today and to learn that you all were O.K., but sorry to learn that you all are having so much rain, I sure was hoping that you all would have some nice weather as you need it so bad. Hope this finds you all well, I am about the same with my bad Cold.

It is still pretty Cold here and it came a new norther today and the wind has blew real hard today. Hope you all have some dry weather now as it is after the first of March now. Hope you got the money O.K. that I sent, be sure and write me as soon as you get it.

No I never saw Everett when I came back by Lillie's, How come you too ask me if I saw him and did Lillie say anything about him in her letter? I sure feel sorry for Lillie as she has to work and make her own living and pay all her expenses just like she didn't even have a husband.

Mama I hope you have good luck with your Chick's when you get them and maybe it will

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be dry and not much cold. Oh yes I got a letter from Della yesterday, they were O.K., she said Milton got deferred from the Army to make a crop. Tell Ellis he better try to get the plank up around ~~his~~ the tomato beds as the rain will wash out all the fertilizier that he put out for the beds. Tell Dennard he sure did a pretty job on the rings and that I sure thank him for making them and sending them too me, a boy wants one of them but I am not going to let him have it. Did he ever get one of those round files? Ellis told me he would get one.

I havent heard from Lillie and E.D. since I come back, but I got a letter from Dorthey and and a birthday folder from E.D. but she never wrote anything. Mamma, do you want me to get you any towels or toilet soap or something? You see I can get stuff like that much cheaper than you can get it as I dont have to pay any tax on anything. Say, how about some parch peanuts? those I brought back up here sure were fine, but they didnt last me long enough. You all take care of yourselves, and real soon.
