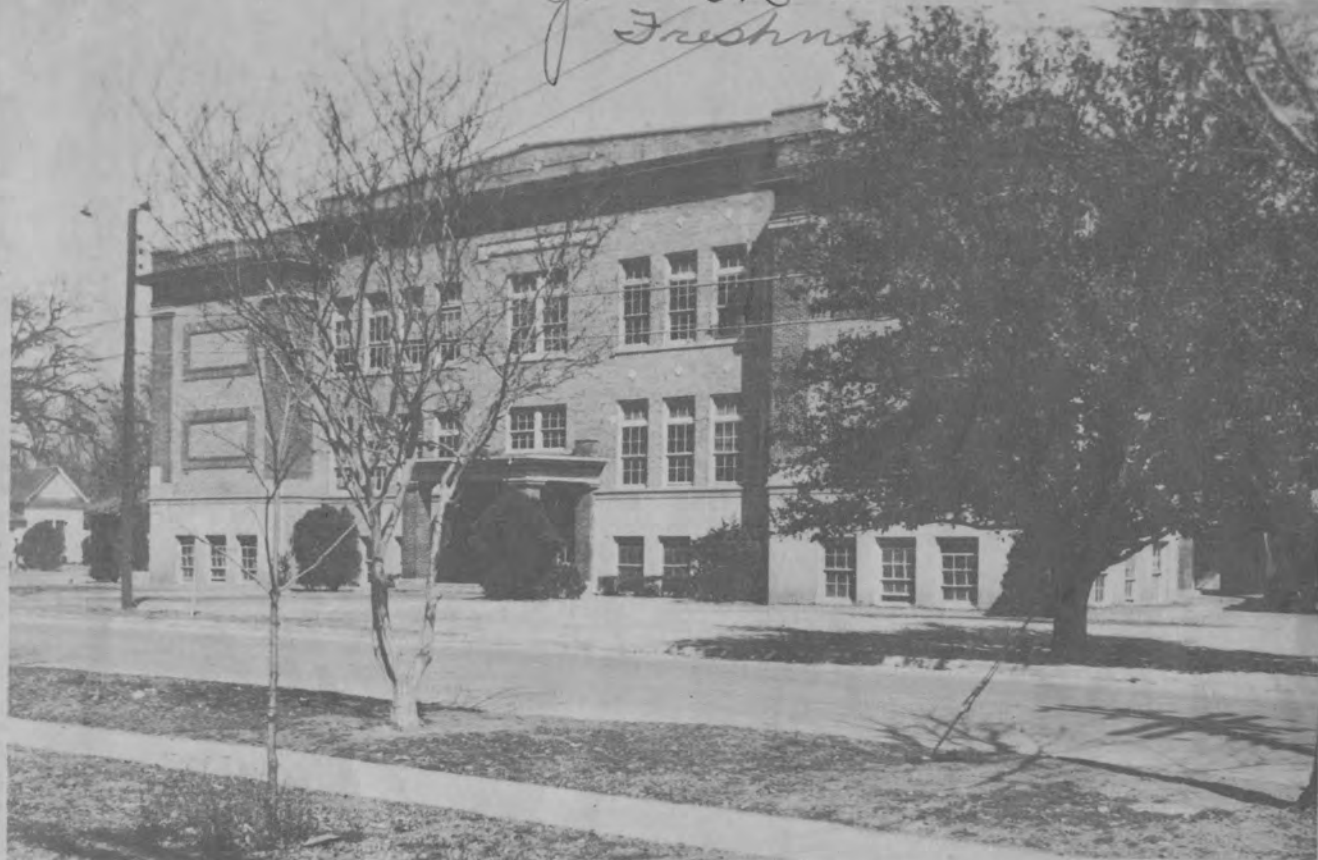


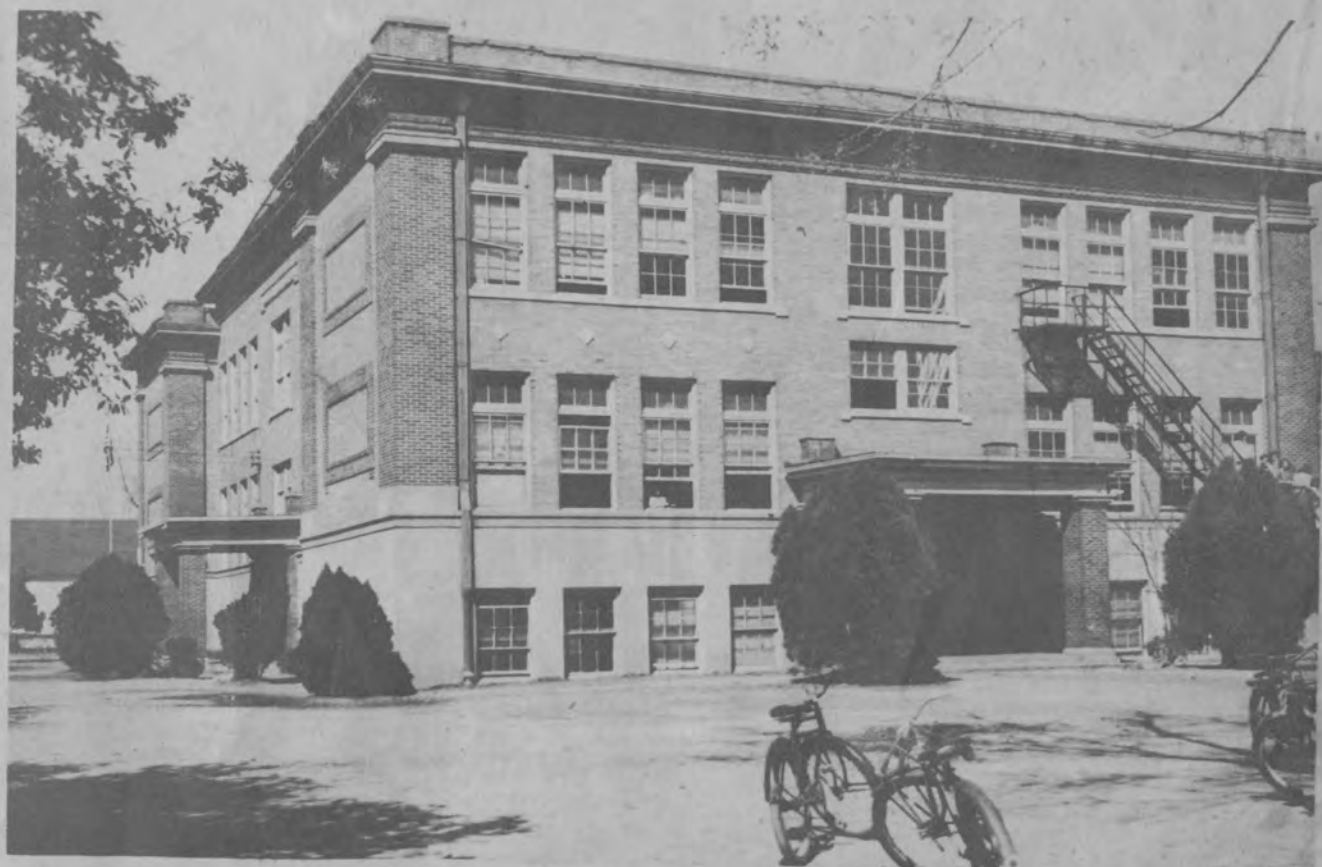

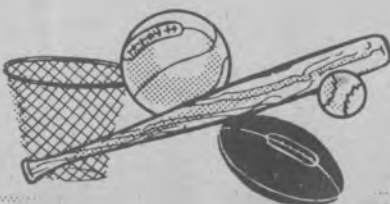

HISTORY OF LUFKIN JUNIOR HIGH

A boy expresses himself in poetic lines concerning history:

"I think of all the things at school
A boy has got to do
That studying history, as a rule,
Is worst of all. **Don't you?

But the history of Lufkin Junior High School is such an interesting one that surely even this lad would enjoy reading it. The pages of our school history reveal many changes, myriad improvements and much progress. Because of the large enrollment in the public schools of Lufkin, a definite need was felt for a junior high school. In 1939 the students of the senior grades went into their new building and the building formerly occupied by the senior grade students was converted into our Junior High School. Mr. Hinson, who was the first principal, has held that position continually since. Teachers who have taught all the years since 1939 are Mrs. Walker, and Mrs. Abney; Misses Tenney, Maroney, and Culbertson. The school has a faculty of twenty full-time teachers and two part-time teachers.

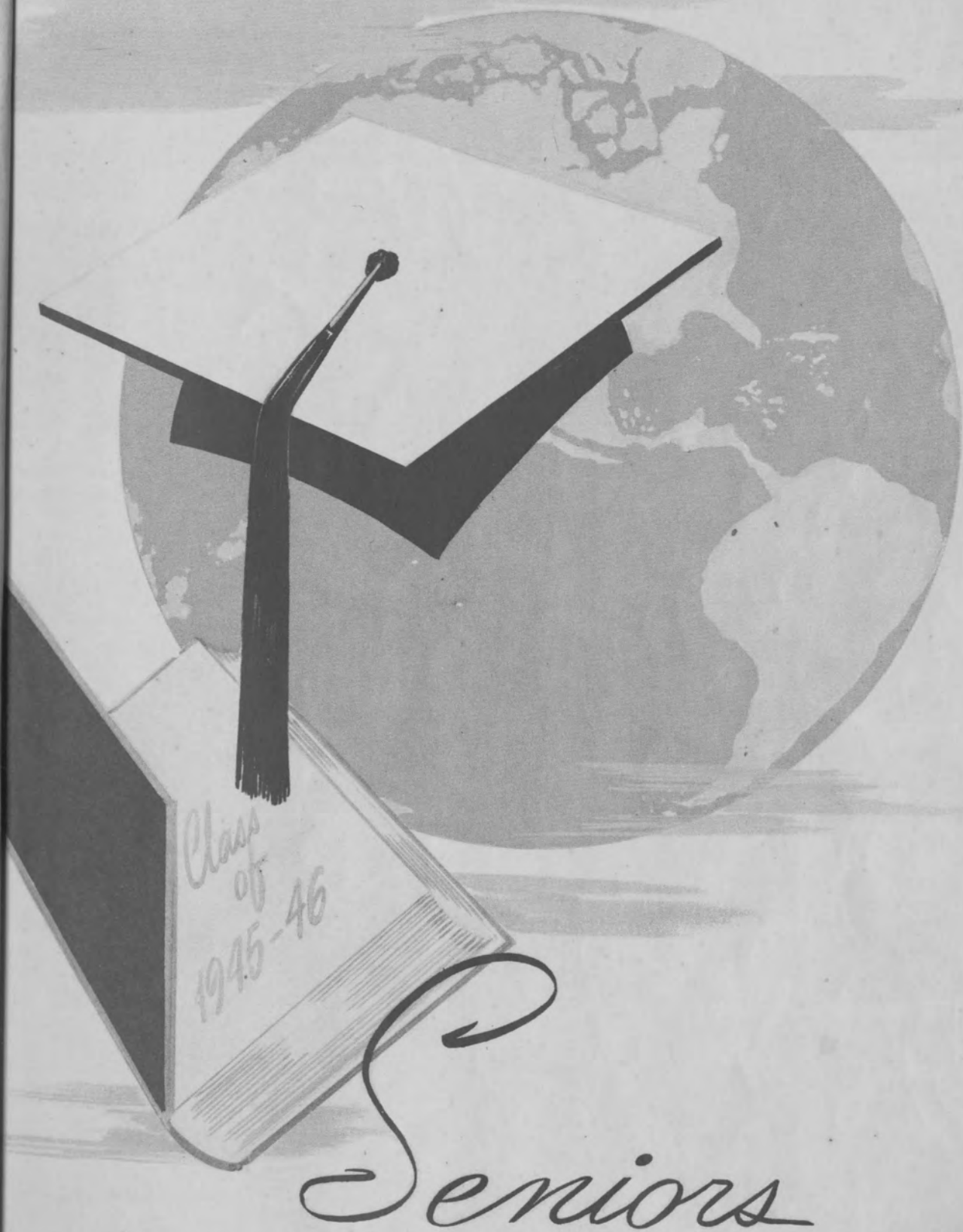
In 1944 the Safety Patrol was organized to help in traffic, campus, and school problems, and has aided a great deal in the prevention of accidents. The National Honor Society was organized the same year and has contributed to a greater zeal for scholarship. The Student Council has made its step forward to aid the entire Student Body, and is one of the most important organizations on the campus.

Material improvements, such as the refinishing of the principal's office and other redecorating jobs, have been made in the past several years. The school is equipped with an attractively furnished room for a teacher's lounge.

The school cafeteria is an added attraction to our facilities, making hot lunches available to all students and teachers.

Many of our six hundred students may "gripe" at times, but all will admit we have a school of which we can be rightly proud. And we're all looking forward to even a larger, more commodious building with an increased course of study.
