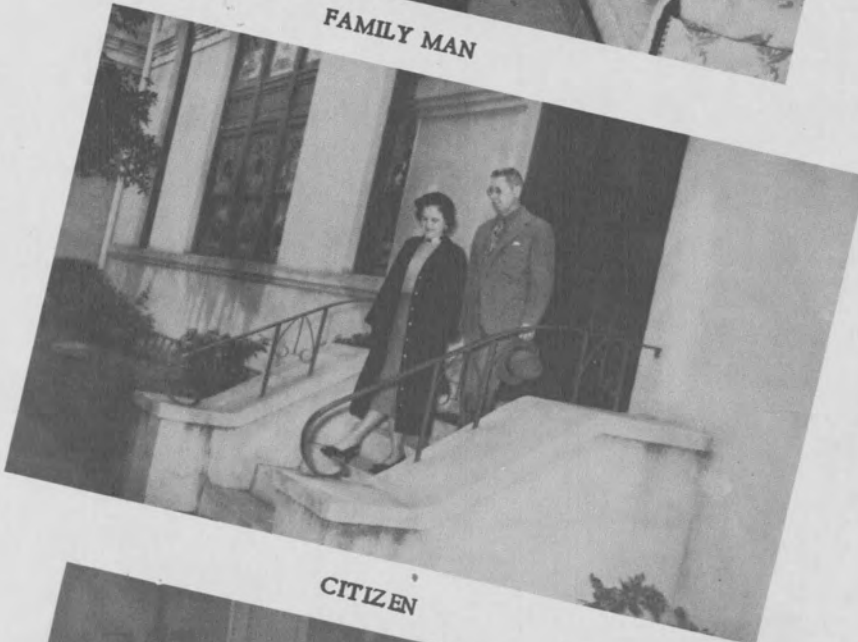

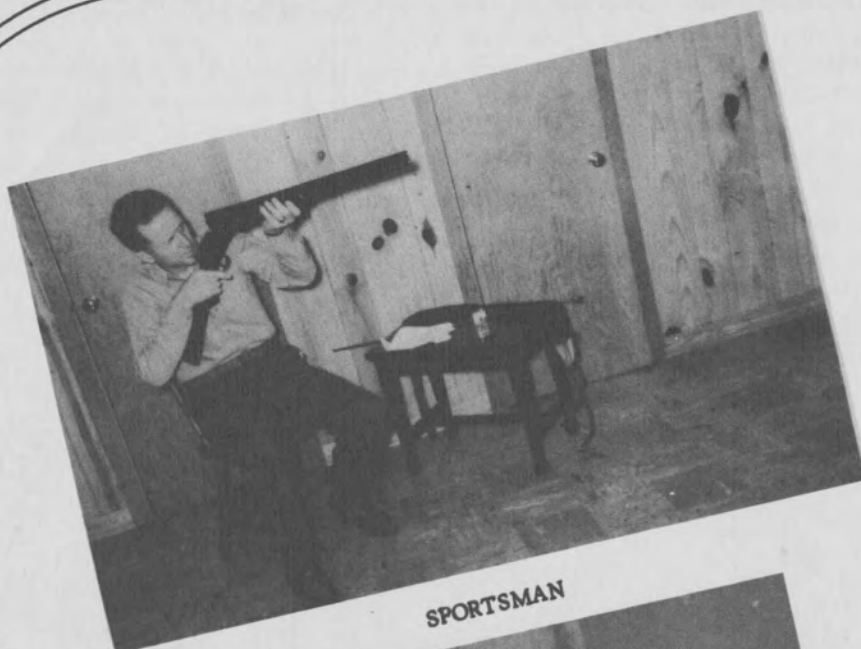

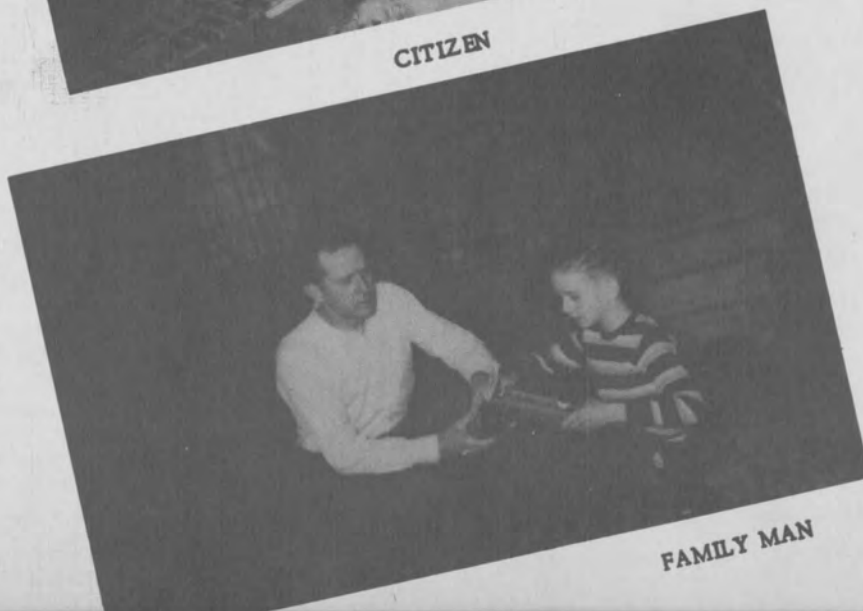

MESSAGE TO THE STUDENTS

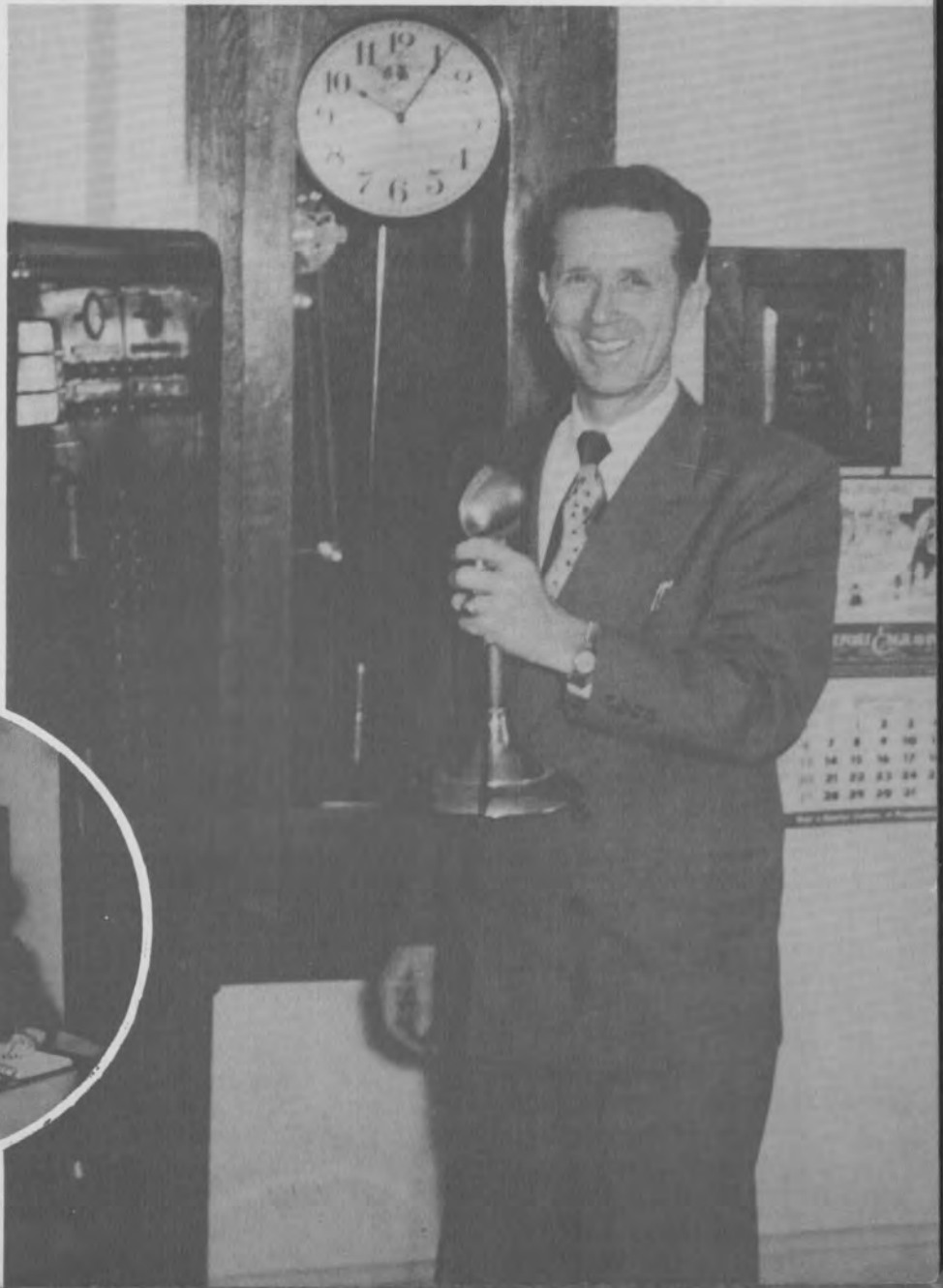
