

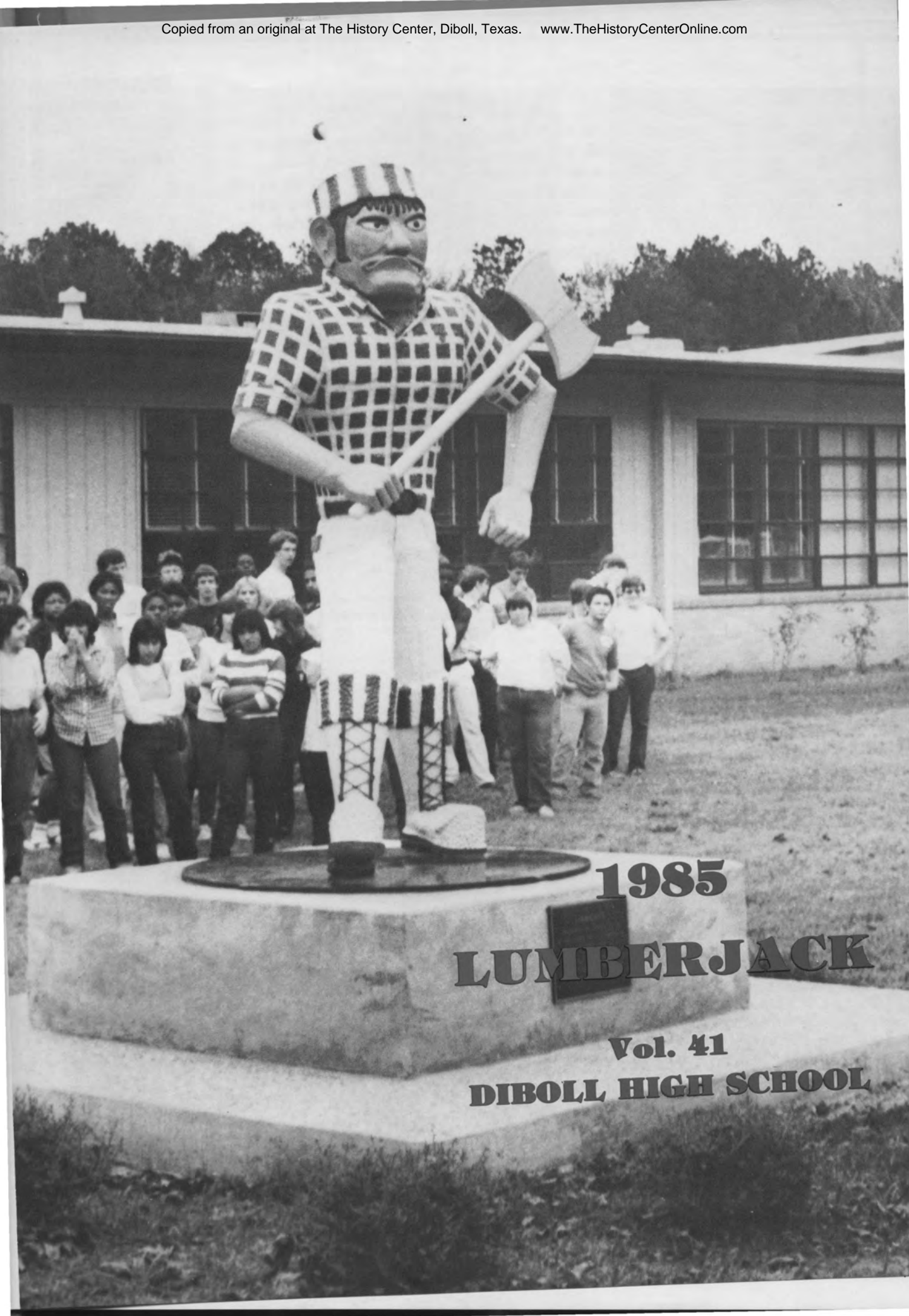

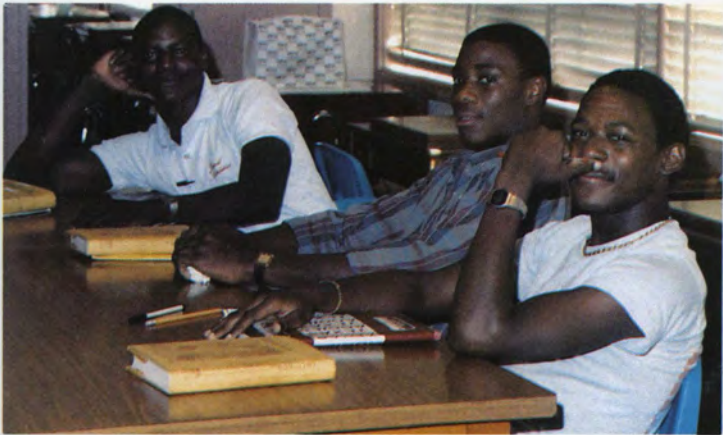
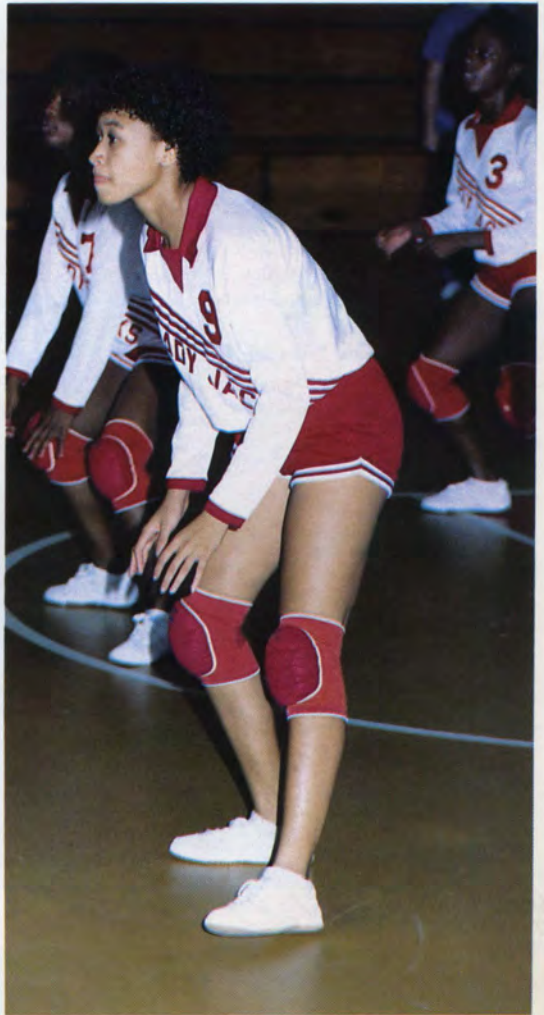
DIBOLL HIGH SCHOOL

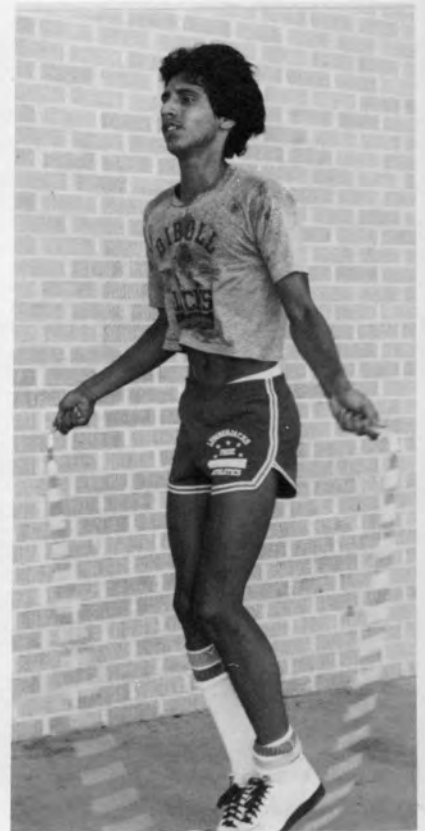


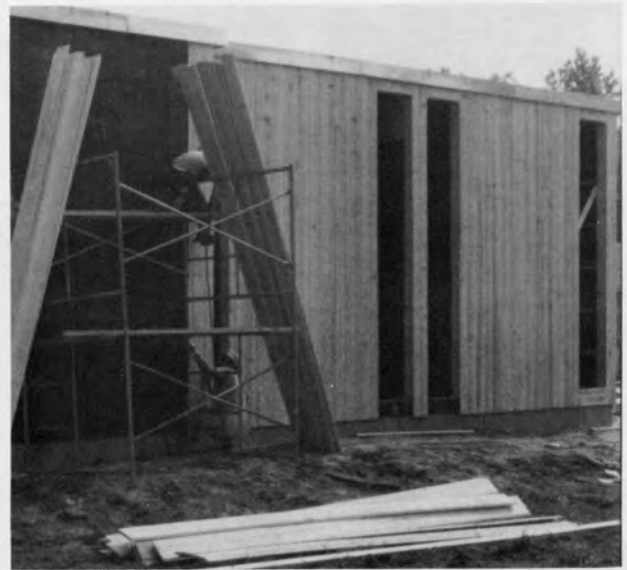

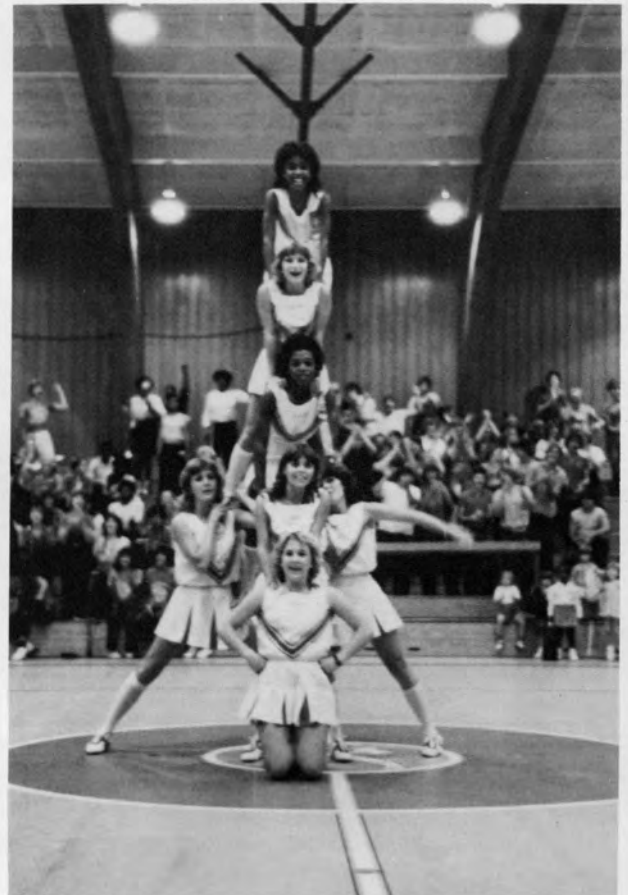

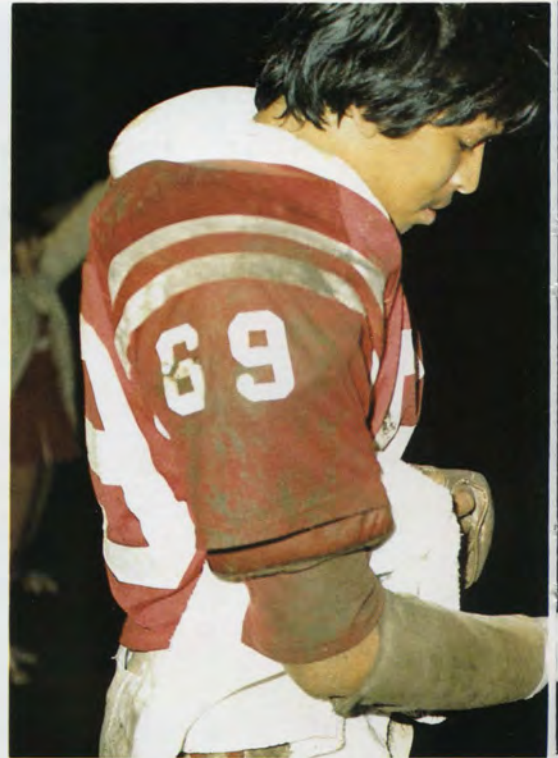

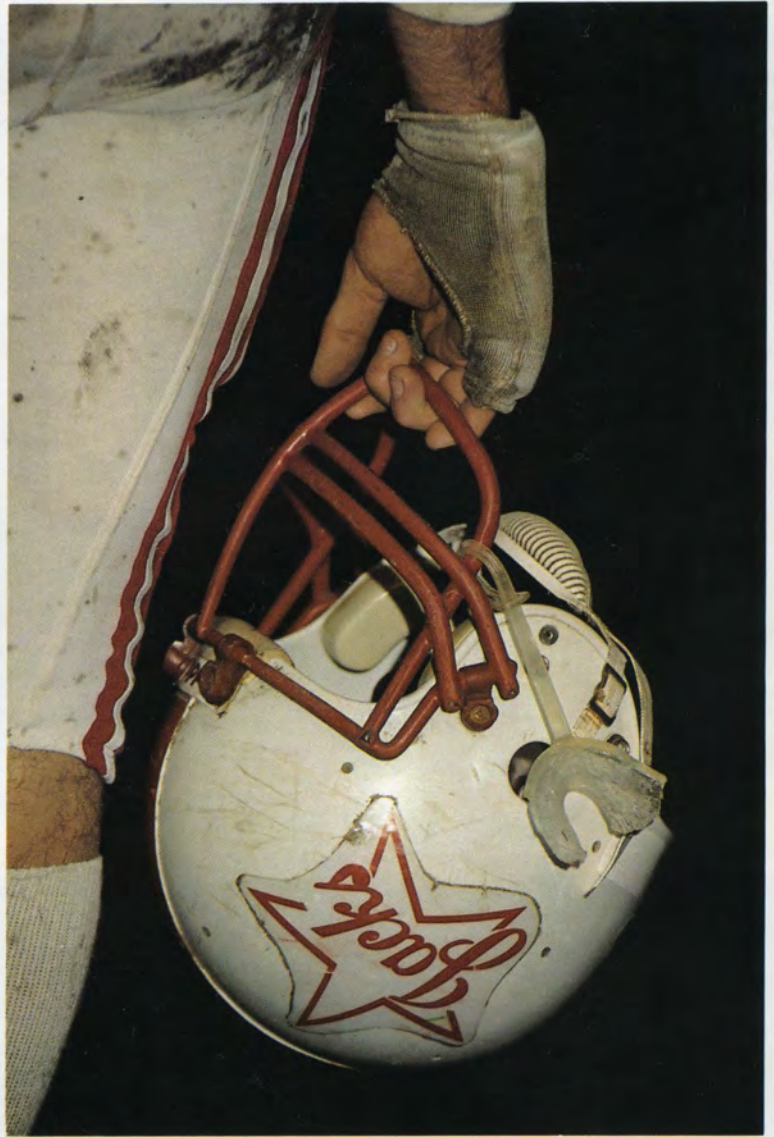

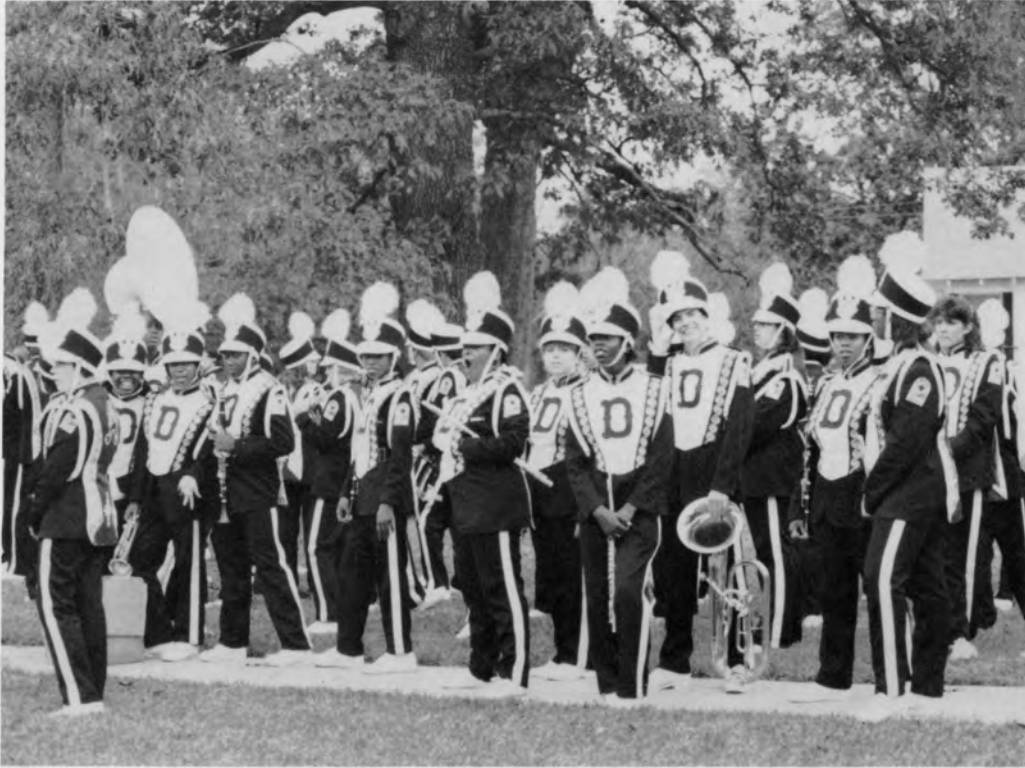

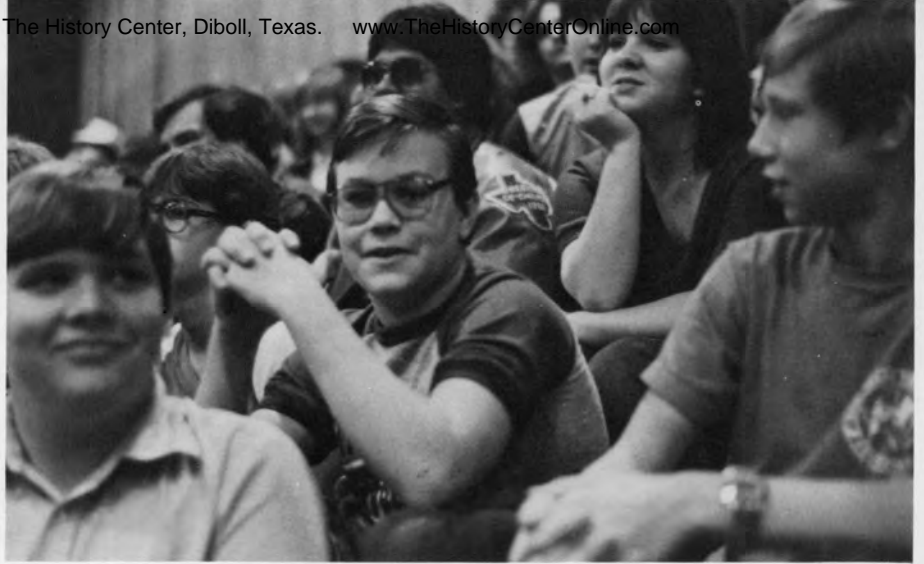


FALL CONSTRUCTION

The goal posts are in place, nets are up, uniforms are ready, lockers assigned, floors polished, and doors opened. Here we go into another year at Diboll High School.

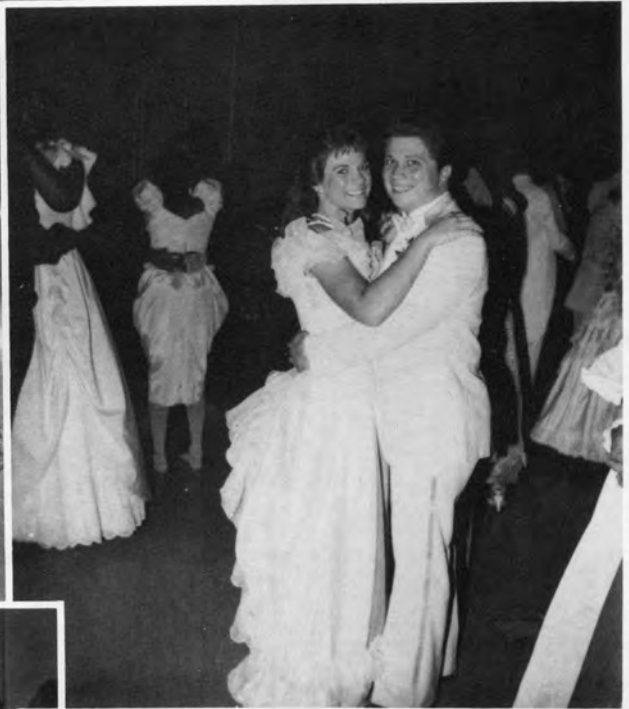

Hey, beaver! Let's play!

River otters often tease friendly, unsuspecting beavers by tugging on their flat tails, then quickly swimming away.

Playful, clowning otters are champion swimmers. They're full of energy and constantly on the move, chasing each other underwater, pushing sticks or leaves along the water's surface, or diving for rocks.

Webbed feet, short legs and streamlined bodies adapt otters to aquatic living. They are the kings of the water acrobats, turning somersaults, swimming on their backs or on their sides, twisting and circling, popping up frequently to catch a breath or just to see what's happening.

Swimming is one of the first skills a young otter learns. Otter mothers know

experience is the best teacher, so they push their two-month-old children headlong into the water, and stand guard until the pups learn how to swim. Of course, they do learn, and very quickly.

River otters can move fairly rapidly on land, although they look less graceful than they do in the water. A land-traveling otter appears to be bouncing.

Otters live in many of the freshwater lakes, rivers and streams surrounding our forestlands. We're committed to preserving their habitat, so future East Texans can enjoy their playful antics.
